


In conjunction with the Parliamentary Education Office

Rotary Adventure in Citizenship (RAIC) is a program run annually in Canberra.

Delegates are selected from different regions and backgrounds around Australia. It is anticipated that all selected delegates have an interest in the Australian Federal Parliament. Many will also have shown leadership in their local schools or communities and displayed the qualities of Australian citizenship.

Whilst in Canberra delegates are hosted in Rotary families or families with a Rotary connection, normally along with another delegate from a different state.

Delegates must be sponsored by their local Rotary Club. Applications should be completed by the nominated student and sent to the RAIC Chairperson, P.O. Box 9001, DEAKIN, ACT 2600.
